ACADEMIC CALENDAR	Two semesters a year First semester: March through July Second semester: August through December
LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION	All courses are given in Spanish. Every semester there are 2-3 courses in English. Students must have an intermediate level of Spanish (B1-B2)
CREDIT SYSTEM	ECTS (European Credit Transfer System). Recommend approximately 20 to 25 credits per semester.
GRADING SYSTEM	The Chilean evaluation system uses a scale of 1.0-7.0, where 4.0 is the minimum passing grade.

DEADLINES	First semester (March through July): November 30th Second Semester (August through December): May 30th

STUDENT VISA	All students must arrive with a student visa. More information in: http://chileabroad.gov.cl/
MEDICAL INSURANCE	Students must arrive in Chile with health insurance purchased in their home country with coverage for the semester/academic year.
